CIRCULAR NO.2

Members are informed that with regard to reservation for women as directed by Hon'ble Supreme Court in MA Diary Number 13992/2023 in CA No. 3401-3402/2003 titled as Supreme Court Bar Association Versus BD Kaushik,

.....We, accordingly, direct that hitherto including for the ensuing election there shall be reservation for women members of the Bar to the following effect: (i) Minimum of 1/3rd seats in the Executive Committee i.e., 3 out of 9. (ii) Minimum 1/3rd out of the Senior Executive Members i.e., 2 out of 6. (iii) At least one post of the Office Bearer shall be reserved for women candidate exclusively by turn and on rotation basis. (iv) In the ensuing election for 2024-2025, the post of Treasurer of the Executive Committee is reserved for women.

7. Though no clarification is required, however, to remove any sort of doubt, it is made clear that reservation is only to guarantee a minimum and women members of the SCBA, subject to their eligibility, shall be entitled to contest the election for all the posts in the Executive Committee.

It has been decided by the Committee that the reservation of women for the post of Member Executive/Senior Member Executive shall be implemented in the following manner:

After filling the first six/four of Member Executive / Senior Member Executive with such candidates (men or women) who have secured highest number of votes, last three/two posts reserved for women will be filled through remaining women members who secured the highest number of votes amongst the said remaining candidates.
