
Subject: Visitor Entry Pass for Learned Advocates.

As requested by the Bar representatives, the practice of insisting on counter signature of the concerned AOR on application(s) for issuance of Visitor Entry Pass by Learned Advocates may be done away with;

Once a Visitor Entry Pass of any Learned Advocate is made, the same shall remain valid for 30 days of its issue;

For access to Court Rooms, the Learned Advocates holding valid Visitor Entry Pass shall be treated at par with those holding Proximity Card and as such, they shall have access to all Court Rooms where their matters are listed on the basis of the said Pass, subject however to SOP on Court functioning notified from time to time to prevent crowding inside Court rooms;

These orders issue on directions of the Competent Authority.
