Respected members are informed that the SCBA is resuming the Covid vaccination Camp from Friday, i.e., 30th April 2021, for all its members above the age of 45 years. On the day of vaccination, the members have to get themselves registered in the waiting area in the Litigants Canteen and thereafter they have to proceed to the Delhi Health Dispensary, Opposite UCO Bank in the Supreme Court premises, where the vaccination would be administered between 10:00 AM to 4:00 PM to the eligible member/ family on a First Come First Serve basis to a maximum of 100 people every day.

Persons coming for vaccination are required to carry any one of the following photo ID documents:

- Aadhar Card
- Electoral Photo Identity Card (EPIC)
- The Photo ID card specified at the time of registration in case of online registration (if not Aadhar or EPIC)
- In case of the Second dose, the certificate issued to the person at the time of 1st dose is mandatory.

Further, members are also informed that it would be advisable to get the vaccine in a proper hospital as we do not have all the medical facilities required in a full-fledged hospital. The fully equipped ICU Ambulance van which was kept as standby for any emergency during the earlier vaccination camp is *also not available* for the members due to sharp rise in Covid cases in and around Delhi. Though it is not mandatory, but we also do not have the paramedics for assisting the members in checking the blood pressure and blood sugar as was available last time.

This COVID-19 vaccination camp is resumed on purely voluntary registration basis and has been initiated by the SCBA as a facilitator and for the convenience of its members and in accordance with the Government guidelines.
