CIRCULAR

A 'PUBLIC DEBATE' for all the candidates for the posts of PRESIDENT and SECRETARY for the Supreme Court Bar Association Election-2025 will be held on **Monday, 19.05.2025 at 3:45 p.m.** in the Supreme Court Lawns in pursuance of Resolution No.1 passed by the General Body in its meeting held on 18.02.2003 which is extracted herein below:-


RESOLUTION NO.1 [18.02.2003]

"That a 'Public Debate' be held in order that all candidates, who are contesting for the post of 'PRESIDENT' and 'SECRETARY', shall inform the members of the Supreme Court Bar the 'Policies' and 'Programs' they propose to adopt, on being elected in such posts, in the Elections to the SCBA, for the Year 2025-26.that since such 'Public Debate' is in consonance with the democratic principles of the electorate being informed of the 'Policies and Programs' That such a 'Public Debate' shall be mandatory for all future Bar Elections."


The candidates for the post of President/Secretary will be entitled to address the members of Bar for maximum 5 minutes each, so as to focus on 'POLICIES & PROGRAMMES' they proposed to adopt on being elected to such posts. The candidates for the post of Secretary will address the gathering first and will be followed by the candidates for the post of President. The Candidates will speak in the order in which their name appears in the Ballot Papers.

It is requested that all the candidates to conform to the requirement of the debate in terms of the aforesaid resolution.

The aforesaid debate will be conducted by members of the Election Committee. The proceedings of the Public Debate will be uploaded on SCBA Website.
